



## 2021-2022 School-Year Programs Tier Pricing Program

Realizing that families without agency funding have differing abilities to pay for Respite Camps, CAMP offers a 3-tier pricing program for overnight Respite Camps during the 2021-22 school year. The \$60 application fee\* is separate and is non-refundable.

Tier 1	\$300	\$750
Tier 2	\$200	\$525
Tier 3	\$100	\$300

**Tier 1** is based on the full cost of a Camper participating in the selected camp. If you are able to pay this amount, please do so.

**Tier 2** is a partially subsidized rate that will enable families that just can't afford the full cost of the camp. Please choose this rate if your family has the need to receive a subsidized rate.

**Tier 3** is a more heavily subsidized rate for families whose Camper(s) would not be able to attend the camp otherwise. If you cannot afford either of the higher rates, please select this tier amount.

### **Proof of Income**

No paperwork showing proof of income, such as IRS 1040's or W2's, is required for the Tier Pricing program during the school year (proof of income is only required for Summer Camp's Scholarship Tier option). All Campers will have the same experience no matter which tier a family is able to pay. The tier voluntarily selected by a family will be kept confidential.

### **\*Agency Funding**

Medicaid Waiver Programs (MWP): Campers who have Respite/Out of Home Respite units through STAR Kids/MDCP, CLASS, TxHmL, HCS, or DBMD do not pay any fees out-of-pocket. This includes the initial \$60 application fee.

Other funding: CAMP also accepts funding from General Revenue, school districts, and other agencies; however, the \$60 application fee DOES apply.
