**Position:** CAMP Counselor (CN)

**Pay Classification:** Volunteer, Seasonal/Weekly

**Reports to:** Chief Cabin Counselor (CCC), Assistant Cabin Counselors (As), and/or Head Instructor (HI)

**Purpose of Job:**

- Interact with and supervise camper(s)

**Essential Job Functions:**

- Serve as Coach and Mentor to other staff, volunteers, and campers
- Interact with and supervise campers in cabin and daily living activities.
- Ensure physical and emotional well-being of campers, including:
  - Feeding of campers
  - Ensuring proper hygiene care of campers
  - Ensuring safety of campers
  - Assisting campers in all activities
- Keep all campers in cabin engaged, both during all activities and during down time
- Assure cabin is clean after each session
- Follow CAMP rules

**Qualifications:**

- Must be at least 15 years of age
- Must possess the personality, character and morals to be a good role model and a caring, conscientious supervisor for campers
- Must be able to live in a cabin and communicate with campers and staff
- Must be able to move about CAMP to activity and program areas
- Must be able to self-regulate emotions in a fast-paced community environment
- Must possess the physical energy needed to perform duties during a 15-hour day, 6-day week
